

It will soon be time to prepare your 2021 tax return. Providing complete and accurate information will allow us to prepare your tax return timely and efficiently. With this in mind, we have attached a checklist and questionnaire to assist you gathering the required items.

#### **Your 2021 Tax Information**

Please review the attached checklist, note any changes and check the items you are including.

#### **Mandatory Electronic Filing**

The CRA requires approved tax preparers to file tax returns electronically. To comply with this new rule, your tax return will be transmitted to the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA). Please answer the related questions on the checklist.

## **Principal Residence Reporting**

All taxpayers who sell their home must report the sale on their tax return, even if it was their principal residence for the whole time they owned it. There are substantial penalties for not reporting the sale. If you sold your home in 2021, provide the details on the attached questionnaire.

#### **Foreign Property Disclosure**

Canadian resident individuals who held property outside Canada with a total cost of more than \$100,000 CAD at any time in the tax year must comply with special reporting to the CRA. There are substantial penalties for non-compliance.

### **Important Dates to Remember**

March 1, 2022 Final date for 2021 RRSP contributions

March 15, 2022 Payment due date for 1rst quarterly 2021 tax instalment

May 2, 2022 Due date for 2021 income tax return due and payment of taxes owing

June 15, 2022 Filing due date for 2021 income tax return due for self-employed individuals
